1. Subject and Predicate

Before going in details about subject and predicate. It should be must discussed that is Sentence.

Sentence-A sentence is a group of words that makes complete sense.

From here, Every sentence has two parts:

i)the subject(the first part of sentence) ii) the predicate(the second part of the sentence.)

i)Subject__As subject is always first part of sentence.so we should always need to place it first.which tells us who or what the sentence is about.

As, Yuvkant's School is in Sherpur.

He is a teacher of maths.

ii)Predicate_The predicate comes after the subject and keeps a verb itself and describe something about subject.

Virat kohli is a player of cricket.

In the above sentence, Virat kohli is subject of the sentence which tells us about who and what the sentence is about.

While predicate Comes after the subject and keeps a verb and tells something about the subject.

Point to be Remember

*Imperative sentences may appear to have no subject. That is because the subject in them is you, which is implied, and so it is omitted.

(You) Write the heading first.

*Questions, or interrogative sentences, do not start with the subject. The subject in questions comes after the verb that starts the sentences.

Is Ajayita a teacher of German?

*The subject does not come first in exclamatory sentences either.

How cute the baby is!

*The predicate must contain a verb. It can also contain other elements like objects, complements or adverbials, all depending on the nature of the verb.

Arijit singh sings a song. (predicate with a verb and object)
